Application deadline & selection procedure

The process of selecting participants, for the funded UN fellowship in Geneva is quite extensive. It takes into account not numbers but the personal stories and backgrounds of the applicants. The goal is to ensure a representation in terms of gender, region and diverse global communities. What sets this process apart is that it considers life human rights situations, in regions when choosing participants.

A special touch in the process involves previously selected indigenous fellows, who play a pivotal role in selecting 15-20 candidates for interviews in their respective languages. Partner universities also join the selection process for applicants applying in specific languages. Ultimately, an advisory group, composed of dedicated OHCHR staff, makes the final selection, ensuring a human touch and a shared commitment to making a difference.

The deadline to apply for the OHCHR Indigenous Fellowship, in Switzerland for 2024 is **September** 30th, 2023.

OHCHR Indigenous Switzerland Fellowship Eligibility Requirements?

To succeed in the application for the OHCHR Indigenous Fellowship Program 2024, you need to fulfill the following eligibility criteria:

- Indigenous applicants are eligible to apply.
- No specific age limit is required for this program.
- No formal education worries/restrictions.
- Applicants must demonstrate a commitment to educating fellow indigenous community members upon their return home.
- Willingness to work for human rights is a crucial criterion.

• Applicants must have a good knowledge of the above-mentioned languages to join this program.

- Fill in the required information accurately.
